District Simplified Grants

- Club donations to The Rotary Foundation (TRF) are invested and used by Rotary
- After 3 years, 20% is returned to the District to use as matching funds for District Simplified Grants (DSG)
- Clubs tell us they don't give to TRF because they want to focus on local projects—DSG's do that

District Simplified Grants

- **Processed and paid by District**
- **Provides for both local and international projects**
 - **Examples: Dictionaries for 3rd graders, wheelchairs, shelter boxes, baseball field, literacy projects, duck derby**
- **Club Applications for a DSG are due September 30 of each year and must be completed online**

District Simplified Grants

- **Committee meets in October:**
 - **District Governor**
 - **District Governor Elect**
 - **Past District Governor**
 - **District Rotary Foundation Chair**
 - **District Grants Subcommittee Chair**

District Simplified Grants District 7750

**2007-2008 Rotary Year
\$24,062 (\$33,750 in Requests)**

**2008-2009 Rotary Year
\$23,350 (\$53,600 in Requests)**

**2009-2010 Rotary Year
\$29,959 (Requests--??)**

Criteria

- Meet requirements for a DSG Project
- Application complete (submitted online) and submitted by 9/30 deadline
- Per capita giving to Rotary Foundation
 - \$100/member to be considered (EREY)
 - Clubs that do not meet this level will be ineligible for a DSG, but can join a project with a club that does

Administration

- **The District Simplified Grant will be processed, approved and paid by DSG Committee after receipt of funds from The Rotary Foundation—usually in December**
- **Very important to keep receipts for all expenditures and submit reports on time**
